
# Attention Students! The Summer Company 2014 is Now Open for Business.

Students looking for summer employment may want to try a different approach than working for someone else and become their own boss instead. Every year students throughout the area face the difficult task of trying to find summer employment. For all of those entrepreneurial students out there, why not think about starting your own summer business and becoming your own boss!

Summer Company is an Ontario Government Program that is in place to motivate and educate students to possibly choose entrepreneurship as a viable career option; equip them with the tools necessary to succeed and provide hands-on business training and mentoring. The program provides awards to help students between the ages of 15-29 in school and returning to school to start and operate their own business throughout the summer months. The successful students can receive up to \$1,500 for business start-up costs and up to \$1,500 upon returning to school in the fall, receive at least 12 hours of business training, and have the opportunity to meet with mentors for support and advice.
